DEREGISTRATION

SPECIAL RESOLUTION DEREGISTRATION

Section 23 provides that a special resolution is one which is passed by not less than three-quarters of such members who are present at a general meeting of which notice specifying the intention to propose the special resolution was given in accordance with the associations rules. Accordingly, proxy voting is not permissible for special resolutions.

Where a special resolution is passed the public officer must, within one month, lodge notice with Consumer Affairs & Fair Trading.

The notice of special resolution must be signed by the public officer. The resolution is required to be sealed with the seal of the association.

Upon approval of the cancellation, notification is sent to the association postal address.

Cancellation of the Incorporation will be published in the Tasmanian Government Gazette.
