AGENT LICENCE - SECURITY AGENT EMPLOYEE LICENCE - SECURITY GUARDING

The Commissioner for Corporate Affairs has selected the following units of competency as the criteria for meeting the requirements of Section 9 of the Act.

Individuals seeking a licence to carry out the activities of a licensee **must** complete the approved units of competency. Applicants may choose to complete **either** Certificate II in Security Operations or the selected units (listed later) from Certificate III in Security Operations.

Both Certificate II and III are eligible pathways for licensees. For more information about the requirements to obtain the qualification please contact one of the Registered Training Organisations listed as delivering this package.

NEW APPLICANTS

Prior to lodging an application form, applicants must have enrolled with a registered training provider and have completed either:

Certificate II units

- Maintain Workplace Safety (PRSS0202);
- Provide first aid (PRSS0206); **or**

Certificate III units

- Maintain a safe workplace and environment (PRSSO302);
- Provide advanced first aid (PRSSO327) (**or** Provide first aid (PRSS0206)).

Once the application is approved, evidence of completion of the remaining required units of competency must be provided within 12 Months of the date of issue of a licence.

Licensees who have not provided this evidence prior to the due date for renewal will be ineligible to renew.

AGENT LICENCE - SECURITY AGENT EMPLOYEE LICENCE - SECURITY GUARDING

The Commissioner for Corporate Affairs has selected the following units of competency as the criteria for meeting the requirements of Section 9 of the Act.

Applicants may choose to complete either Certificate II or selected units from Certificate III (see next page) in Security Operations.

In the case of Certificate II (which must be fully completed by licensees in the first 12 months) you will be required to complete 7 core units and 4 electives.

AGENT LICENCE - SECURITY AGENT EMPLOYEE LICENCE - SECURITY GUARDING

The Commissioner for Corporate Affairs has selected the following units of competency as the criteria for meeting the requirements of Section 9 of the Act.

Applicants may choose to complete either Certificate II or selected units from Certificate III in Security Operations. In either case the specified units must be completed within 12 months of the date of issue of a licence.

Completion of the following selected units of competency will not enable a licensee to fully achieve the qualification 'Certificate III in Security Operations'.

We anticipate that in most cases licensees will complete the remaining units of competency required to achieve their qualification. Certainly we would expect this to be the case for those licensees undertaking traineeships.

The Commissioner has also identified that there are significant ongoing issues associated with requiring licensees to maintain their competence in unit '*PRSS0327 Provide advanced first aid*' and will therefore accept '*PRSS0202 Provide first aid*' if licensees choose to have their competence assessed in this unit instead.

Applicants who choose to undertake the selected units of competency from Certificate III will not be eligible for the full qualification unless they choose to undertake further training. In order to obtain the qualification applicants are required to complete 9 core units and 4 elective units.
